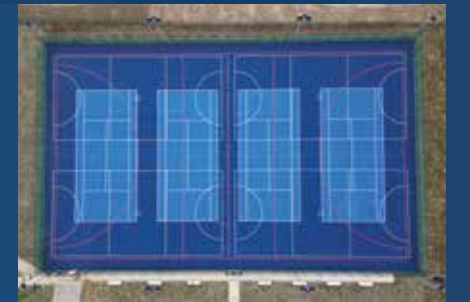

The Avanti approach to Teaching and Learning

Teaching and learning in all Avanti Schools is underpinned by the Avanti Teacher Toolkit. Our teachers and teaching assistants are guided by the 12 Avanti Habits, rooted in cognitive science and evidence-informed practice. All our teachers are continuously developing their practice through exceptional professional development from the Avanti Institute, ensuring that our young people benefit from the highest quality teaching in every lesson.

12 elements of great teaching and learning in Avanti Schools

Through a planned programme of training and development supported by The Avanti Institute, we ensure that all our schools have a highly developed sense of what constitutes great teaching. We continuously train and coach our staff on every feature of high quality pedagogy, in order that every young person gets an education that is second-to-none.



We ensure that all our teachers:

1. Build positive relationships with learners and each other
2. Begin and end lessons calmly with familiar routines
3. Use intentional seating and classroom set up
4. Create a flourishing learning environment by managing behaviour effectively
5. Have clear and ambitious learning intentions for all young people
6. Are always context considerate and adapt practice appropriately
7. Activate daily review of prior learning
8. Present new material in small steps
9. Provide modelling and scaffolding
10. Give opportunities for guided and independent practice
11. Ask effective questions and check for learner understanding
12. Review learning regularly before moving on to new content

Curriculum

The Avanti Grange curriculum inspires courageous, curious and resilient learners with a lifelong love of learning and empower them to make the world a better place.

Our curriculum immerses young people in the powerful knowledge and intellectual conversations of a broad range of subject disciplines, equipping them to make sense of the world around them and to excel in a range of fields. By nurturing young peoples' sense of identity and perspective, purpose and connection, it creates capacity for informed and conscientious collaboration now and in the future.

Our core virtues, core beliefs and golden threads of connection run throughout the curriculum, ensuring that educational excellence, character formation and spiritual insight are equally developed.

For the first three years (Years 7, 8 and 9), young people follow a broad and challenging academic curriculum, including the following subjects:

- English
- Mathematics
- Science
- Geography
- History
- Philosophy, Religion and Ethics (PRE)
- Modern foreign languages: French
- Computer Science
- Design and Technology
- Art
- Music
- Drama
- Personal, social and health education (PSHE)
- Physical education (PE)
- Yoga and meditation

A school-wide approach to literacy, as well as a generous allocation of curriculum time to English and Maths, ensures learners build firm foundations in literacy and numeracy in Key Stage 3. These enable learners to thrive in school, and to succeed at a range of subjects at GCSE (Years 10 and 11) and in their adult lives.

Young people will select their GCSE options in Year 9, in preparation for Key Stage 4, and will typically study for nine or ten GCSEs.

Our Sixth Form curriculum will focus primarily on the most academic A levels. This will allow our young people to gain places at the very best Russell Group universities. Our Oxbridge programme will support young people with applications and interviews at both Oxford and Cambridge.

Personal development

Enrichment

Enrichment is a key part of young peoples' learning and personal development at Avanti Grange Secondary School. We host a range of opportunities for young people to engage further with their academic learning and to develop key character formation qualities through a range of events, visits, extended learning days, co-curricular clubs and super curricular activities.

Student leadership

There are many opportunities for our young people to develop their leadership skills at Avanti Grange Secondary School, both within curriculum areas and our co-curricular provision. We aim to provide opportunities for our students to develop leadership skills by succeeding together as a community through a shared vision and our ethos, using young person voice to make our school the best it can be. Student leadership is continually evolving as learners take on more leadership roles and is ever expanding. Examples of student leadership roles include:

Uniform

Uniform and achievement have always been a high priority for Avanti Schools Trust. We believe the way in which young people wear their school uniform reflects the importance which is placed on attention to detail and pride in the school. School lunches

Wellbeing wisdom

Avanti staff have access to regular wellbeing sessions. Our previous sessions have been led by medical professionals, corporate coaches and even monks! We discuss everything from how to overcome stress to learning about meditation.



Retreats

Staff and young people will get have an opportunity to go to regular Avanti Quest retreats. These are fantastic retreats with a focus on character development and spiritual insight. They also allow; individuals to nurture and develop more friendships, engage in fulfilling activities whilst going out of their comfort zone, improve overall wellbeing and reconnect with nature.

Every young person has access to Yoga and Mindfulness lessons which are timetabled. Yoga and Mindfulness help ground young people, relieve stress and improve their overall health and wellbeing.

Our vision was for a family of schools based upon our core principles of educational excellence, character formation, and spiritual insight. 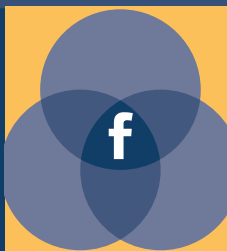
